Safeguarding Children at Richard Lander School

Richard Lander School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. This means that we have a Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy, and procedures in place which we refer to in our prospectus. All staff, including supply staff, volunteers and governors, must ensure that they are aware of these procedures. Parents and carers are welcome to read the Policy which is on the school website. Sometimes we may need to share information and work in partnership with other agencies when there are concerns about a child's welfare. Whenever possible we will ensure that our concerns about children are discussed with his/her parents/carers first unless we have reason to believe that such a move would be contrary to the child's welfare. The designated staff in school for Child Protection and Safeguarding concerns are Mrs Y Rippon - Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead & Mrs J Griffiths – Deputy Head Teacher, Designated Safeguarding Lead.
